Subject: ACIAR LWR/2002/018 : Record of phone hook-up Wednesday 12 April 2006

Hi All,

Following is the record of our phone hook-up conducted on Wednesday 12 April 2006.

Present from ISWC in Yangling (10:00 local time) were Prof Li Rui, Yang Qinke, Zhao Yong'an, Wen Zhongming and Liu Zhihong

Present from CLW in Canberra (12:00 local time) were Tim McVicar, Li Lingtao, Lu Zhang and Zhang Xiaoping (from ISWC who is currently visiting CLW)

 Topics for discussion are followed by the decisions and actions.

1) Format of ReVegIH user guide and 2) is a full Chinese version of the ReVegIH user guide needed?

ACTION: It was decided that CLW will continue with plans to produce the user guide with the two languages interleaved. CLW will then print 50 hard copies and will serve the electronic PDF file on the CLW Web-site. CLW will then send the WORD file to China so ISWC may make a Chinese only version of the user guide. ISWC will e-mail the Chinese only version so CLW can check it. ISWC will print the necessary copies of the user guide needed for the training courses (ISWC will run these training courses in China) and the 300 to 400 copies needed to be mailed out to all the relevant (Forestry, Hydrology and Agriculture) Bureau Heads in the CSHC study site.

3) Gain agreement on the tasks that ISWC will lead in the 12 month extension (1 July 2006 to 30 June 2007)

Prof Li Rui agreed that ISWC would take the lead and deliver on objectives #2 and #3 as documented in the 12-month extension proposal.

ACTION: Tim will report the agreement from ISWC for our 12 month extension to Ian Willett.

4) Do the two software developers (Zhao Yong'an and Zhang HongMing) have passports? If yes, we can start to issue letters of invitation from CLW so they can successfully apply for their visa to enter Australia. If no, they need to apply for a passport quickly.

Zhao Yong'an has an official passport, whereas Zhang HongMing does NOT have an official passport, receiving an official letter of invitation from CLW will assist him in getting his passport quickly. They both need this official letter of invitation to get their Australian visas. The plan is for both Zhao Yong'an and Zhang HongMing to travel to Australia for 30 days in September 2006. ISWC agreed with these dates.

ACTION: Tim will work with CLW administration to get the letters of invitation sent to Yangling as soon as possible.

5) Any other items that Prof Li Rui, or any one else in ISWC, would like to discuss with us from CLW.

Tim asked Yang Qinke for justification why the Chinese Academy of Sciences Knowledge Renovation Project KZCX3-SW-421 should be acknowledged in the ReVegIH user guide. Tim wants to know this as unnecessarily acknowledging another project reduces the impact of ACIAR funding of LWR/2002/018. Yang Qinke could not answer right away; he needs time to think about this issue.

ACTION: Yang Qinke agreed to send Tim an e-mail documenting the proposed justification by the end of today. Once Tim receives this e-mail he will make a decision in consultation with Yang Qinke. If Yang Qinke's e-mail is not received today, then Tim will delete acknowledgement to KZCX3-SW-421 in the ReVegIH user guide.

6) Discussion led by Liu Zhihong about met data interpolation using ANUSPLIN.

ACTION: Liu Zhihong decided to send an e-mail directly to her CLW colleagues.

There were no other topics for discussion raised by anyone who was part of the phone hook-up.
